Minutes for the Capital Area Service Committee
January 15, 2017

Meeting called to order at 2:00 pm with the Serenity Prayer and reading of the N.A. Twelve Traditions and Twelve Concepts.

Roll Call

16 out of 50 Home Groups were represented. 12 Officers and subcommittee chairpersons were present.

Approval of Minutes

Minutes were approved.

Concerns/Open Forum

-Greg made the body aware of the incorrect name for the "Serenity Fellowship Reunion" noted as "Serenity Fest" in last month's minutes. The correct name is "Serenity Fellowship Reunion".

-Chris informed the Body that Durham Area (New Hope Area of NCNA) would like to present a request to combine their area and our area conventions. Chris would like to meet with the referenced people (see Chris). In response, a vote was passed to have a separate ad-hoc committee to meet with and listen to the proposal and information to bring back to this body. The vote was For-9; Against-0; and Abstain-6.

-Life on Life's Terms has two experienced members who attend this meeting while there are about 45-60 newcomers from shelters, etc attending this meeting. The concern was trusted servants and questioning whether one of the experienced members could be a trusted servant (GSR) and hold a subcommittee/officer position. The emphasized that it is SUGGESTED not to, but encourage this member to "do what you have to do to keep the doors open to the newcomer" or "revisit keeping this homegroup opened.

-Greg provided and reviewed the financial report from the Serenity Fellowship Reunion in regards to concern of last month's questioning of "where did the money go". Greg informed the body that he is Vice Chair of the Committee. RCM and Greg discussed concerns regarding finances and the organization as a 501(c)(3) Organization. Greg reports that he does have receipts.

Chairperson (Julius J) –Written report provided.

Happy New Year! Looking forward to this year, striving to promote an atmosphere of recovery. **Please remember to submit motions to address concerns mentioned prior to business meetings during the monthly ASC meetings.**

Vice Chair (Richard B) –No report.

Secretary (Candis D.) – Written report. directory. Also fill out the "Capital Area Meeting Information Form" for any new home groups or changes such as location and time.

RCM (Sheryl) -Verbal report given. Written report to be given. Region and World has taken a look at the "Serenity Fellowship Reunion" because of 7th Tradition and Autonomy affecting NA as a whole. South Carolina Region member was upset about the Capital Area coming in the S.C. to hold an event without contacting anyone in that area. They are requesting that you come to their Area Meeting to let them know what you plan on doing. The budget and proposal for H&I Behind the Walls did pass but right now no volunteers for the Behind the Wall; get with me or Gina. For Conventions make sure that financial reports and details are available for IRS. 9 areas were present. Would like to get a plan up to get the other homegroups to participate in the. I will get with PR and would like to present this plan to the Region in April. The Region is having a Learning Day on March 11, 2017 in Rock Hill, SC at 10:30am. Encourage to send at least one volunteer. Several positions open. The Region has a motion to send \$█████ to NAWS. There are Social Media concerns about people taking pictures at events and posting with other addicts- this is breaking anonymity. There is a pamphlet and suggest taking and reading this at your homegroups. EEC Coastal Convention in Virginia at a college and all monies buys books for people Behind the Walls (books have been donated). Another motion out "Low Country Mental Health Conference" in Charleston, SC. for no more than \$█████ to send 4 people \$█████ for the booth, \$█████ for 4 people for two days, and \$█████ for pamphlets. Anyone can attend. All Regions want to do a World Audit for Financial Reports (transparency).

Alt. RCM (Gina)-No report.

Treasurer (Tim H.)- Written report. **There is a Revised November 2016 Statement. As of December 8, 2016, the starting account balance was: \$█████. No deposits made in December (Deposit is on November Statement). Homegroup Donations in December totaled \$█████. Sebastian paid \$█████; Nikki paid \$█████; total deposits in December 2016 was \$█████. The December Deposit was made before the November statement closed out (see Revised November Income and Expense Report) \$█████ in checks and deductions. The ending account balance as of 01.09.2017 is \$█████. No Outstanding Checks not cleared. This leaves an available balance of \$█████ This available balance puts us \$█████ ABOVE the policy mandated prudent reserve.**

Policy Chair (Malinda J.)- Written report. This month, I did not contact any Subcommittee Chairpersons, primarily b/c of the work being done to transform the PR, OUTREACH and H&I Committees into one Committee. I talked to our H&I Chair this morning, and WE agreed that, for now, let's allow him to focus on this huge project; but, again, figure out something, with your help. I've updated our POLICY Manual, incorporating last month's APPROVED Motion. I did delete the "Capital Area Treasurer's Procedural Manual". I renumbered the Appendixes to 1 & 2; then deleted the Literature budget line out of the Capital Area Financial Policy (on pg 16). **Reminder please look at the 3 motions that I put in back in November 2016 and take to discuss with homegroups.**

Policy Alternate (Vacant).

PR (Craig R) - Written report. We printed 700 meeting lists for groups this month. Even though we list every meeting in our area, we strive to print what is actually needed and distribute to those present. Any homegroup can contact me for meeting list. We conducted our monthly PR presentation at First Steps in Raleigh. We also participated in a community based Drug Awareness night in Apex. Attendees included county/city law enforcement, mental health and substance abuse professionals, NC Harm Reduction, local politicians and AA. The website had 4,584 visitors who visited 19,897 pages. If anyone would like to be added to the Eblast mailing list, there is a link on the website to request being added. The FB group has continued to go well and has 13 members. **I want to begin discussions of directly paying the vendor for meeting lists and eliminate any member paying for them and having to be reimbursed. The UPS store allows for an account to be established that we could pre pay. We also want to initiate a conversation with the GSRs about having literature on hand for PR and H&I and paying for it directly. A draft of some proposed guidelines for this site is attached with the minutes. We have**

begun some initial discussions on the advantages and disadvantages of consolidating the PR, H&I and Outreach subcommittees into one umbrella subcommittee. We requested and received \$ [REDACTED] for literature and literature rack to be used in upcoming presentations. These were funds from the PR budget that covered November, December and January. Meeting lists were \$ [REDACTED]. We also requested \$ [REDACTED] reimbursement for purchasing supplies and associated laminations for the PR display. We would like to get more people involved either as PR volunteer or participant. We are still recruiting a vice chair, alternate phone line and meeting list coordinators. Please pass that on to your home group members. Come out to our subcommittee meeting every first Sunday at 12:30.

H&I Chair (David K.)– Written report. We had 11 members in attendance of the meeting. 3 people were oriented. Open positions are Vice Chair, Secretary, Alt. Secretary. Convention Chair (Teddy K.) Written report provided. Thank everyone that helped with our last two functions! Both were successful! For upcoming events the door fees will be \$ [REDACTED] per person and \$ [REDACTED] per couple. Our next Event is on February 18, 2017 The Annual Red & White Extravaganza (SEE FLYER). The phone line recording of meetings has been updated to be consistent with our printed meeting list and website. We conducted our monthly PR presentation at First Steps in Raleigh. We also participated in a community based Drug Awareness night in Apex. Attendees included county/city law enforcement, mental health and substance abuse professionals, NC Harm Reduction, local politicians and AA. Our participation consisted of a PR member sharing with the audience about NA and having our PR display set up with sample literature and meeting lists available. We also want to initiate a conversation with the GSRs about having literature on hand for PR and H&I and paying for it directly instead of members coming out of their personal funds to buy it or using a personal credit card/pre pay card. The website had 4,584 visitors who visited 19,897 pages. The web servant position was very busy over the weekend of the snow event. "The Web Servant will maintain the Area Facebook group titled "Capital Area Serenity". The purpose of the group will be to help facilitate communication between members, groups and subcommittees of the Capital Area about current and upcoming announcements. Some examples of this are event announcements such as: home group anniversaries, open service commitments, upcoming subcommittee events, group closures, ASC announcements, etc.

The following are guidelines for the Facebook Group to follow when moderating the group:

1. No posting pictures of other members. Pictures that don't include faces but that are NA related are acceptable. An example of this might be a picture of where an area event might be held or a meeting space without members in the picture.
2. No posting about non-announcement topics such as: inspirational quotes, discussion topic debates, personal attacks on other members, groups or service bodies.
3. No posting anything that breaks any of our 12 steps, 12 traditions or 12 concepts.
4. The Group is intended for members of Narcotics Anonymous.
5. Regarding Facebook's privacy settings, it will remain a "Closed" group. This means that someone must request to join. It also means that the group IS searchable on Facebook.
6. We ask that members not blindly add other members to the group that have not expressed an interest in being added to the group.
7. Any NA member may post to the group, not just members of PR or Admins.
8. At least one other PR member will be added as an Admin in addition to the Web Servant.

The admins will help ensure that the postings done in the group are in line with the agreed upon and approved guidelines

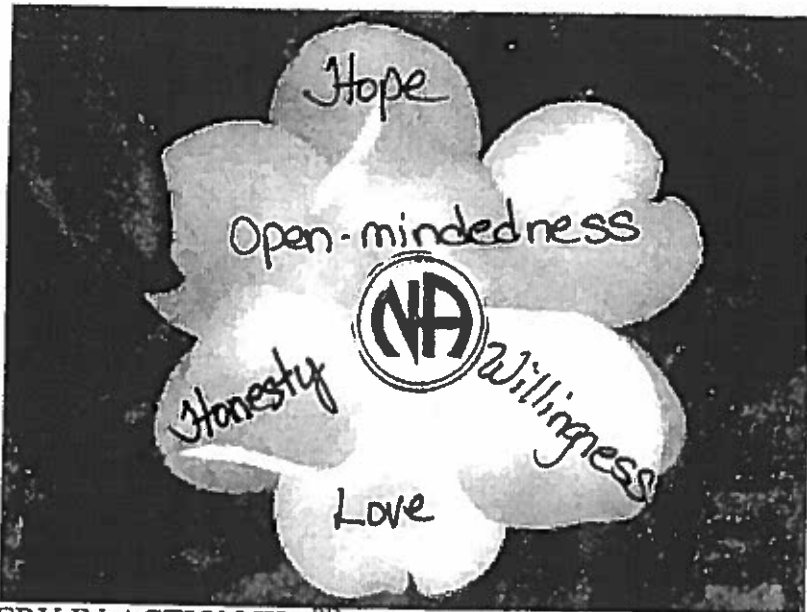
