

Minutes for the Capital Area Service Committee September 11, 2016

Meeting called to order at 2:00 pm with the Serenity Prayer and reading of the N.A. Twelve Traditions and Twelve Concepts.

Roll Call

24 out of 56 Home Group GSR's present. 11 Officers and subcommittee chairpersons were represented. Three of those positions were voted in today (see resumes).

Approval of Minutes

Minutes were approved.

Concerns/Open Forum

Reminder about the history of the homegroups.

It was suggested that we begin having more discussions at our homegroups in regards to GSR's lack of attendance at the CASC meetings.

The behaviors and incidents that have occurred amongst the trusted servants of the Convention Committee is negatively affecting the Area and fellowship as a whole. One member of the homegroup Candlelight Recovery expressed concern that these behaviors could lead to the church no longer allowing them to hold homegroup meetings at that location. Another concern was that the person involved in both incidents has been voted by the Convention Committee to remain in that position in spite of such behaviors. Please note that the behavior not the person is the concern. Another member expressed concern that the discord amongst the Convention Committee has taken place over the past 2 years and now has surfaced to reach the Area.

A member expressed concern of subcommittee having the meeting in the home of an addict and suggests that it be held at a neutral location to allow others to attend. Also concerned with Convention Committee requiring an addict to attend 2 meetings in order to vote, "this is not in alignment with any other policies on voting".

The Convention Committee policy on page 5 3rd paragraph under "Disruptive Behavior" was read in regards to removal of a trusted servant from a position as reads: "The removal process will be conducted by the executive committee. The final authority of any removal will rest with the CASC". A member requested that this be addressed in old business as this motion was presented last month.

There was discussion in regards to "all" treasurers for every Subcommittee to have streamline reporting or form remains.

Subcommittee, Officer and Ad-hoc reports (see attached)

Chairperson (Julius J) –Written and verbal report provided.

Since the last Area Meeting in August, I have received calls about several mishaps that may be discussed in open forum/concerns, which seemed to had been resolved per the Vice Chair of the Convention Subcommittee on Thursday.

Vice Chair (Richard B) – No report.

Secretary (Candis D.) – Written report provided.

The Women in Recovery Group has a meeting location change. They are back in their old meeting location: 319 S. East St, Raleigh. On today we were notified that they requested that this is not changed in the meeting directory.

RCM (Vacant.) –The next RSC meeting is in Wilmington, NC on October 8, 2016 at 10:30am. No location was provided.

Treasurer (Tim H.)– Report Submitted. Starting account balance was [REDACTED] on 8/6/16. [REDACTED] was deposited on 8/8/16. [REDACTED] in checks and deductions. Homegroup donations last month was [REDACTED]. The ending account balance is [REDACTED] as of 9/8/16. This available balance puts us [REDACTED] ABOVE the policy mandated prudent reserve. Policy Chair (Malinda J.)– Written Report. An updated policy manual is now available on the CASC website which includes all approved motions up to and throughout July 2016. Any motions voted on will be held in hard copy until the end of the quarter and will be updated in the Policy every 3 months. There remains no clear policy direction about what to do when there is no Subcommittee Policy Contact or on updating of Subcommittee Policy for consistency with CASC Policy. Please discuss or motion.

Policy Alternate (Jeremy C.) Voted in on today!!

PR (Craig R) – Craig R voted in today and provided a verbal report.

A literature coordinator was elected on today. There were 4101 website visitors. 13264 page views. We meet every 1st Sundy at 12:30pm and welcome others to participate as well as any ideas that you may want to bring. We have added a “FAQ” link. We are discussing adding events of the surrounding areas to the website and will bring more information to the ASC later. We have also briefed on creating a facebook page. Local objective is to help members understand what your role is in public relations, we all have a role to play. Anyone who is thinking about starting a meeting, we encourage you to engage with PR committee for suggestions. Suggested doing a PR presentation everywhere that we go including facilities and within subcommittees. Encouraged people to use PR committee to talk about “what we do and what we don’t do”.

H&I Chair (David K.)– Written report. All facilities are being served. H&I Chair addressed concerns of policy in his report (see attached). Females with bluecards can see Stephanie for orientation in December to continue to be of service in those facilities.

Outreach Chair (Craig E.) – No reports. Craig E. has put in a resume for this position on today and was voted in. Thanks for your willingness to be of service!!

Activities Committee Chair (Lahoma S.) –Written report provided. We are asking for donations or homegroups to bring a covered dish. **Appreciation Day will be held on September 24, 2016 at Biltmore Park in Raleigh. The menu is hotdogs, hamburgers, baked beans, sides, and covered dishes provided by homegroups. Contact information in written report.**

Convention Chair (April B.) Written report provided and financial report provided to ASC Treasurer by Secretary. We are continuing the planning stages of the upcoming convention 2017. We are financially in need of continued support from the fellowship as a whole. The Raleigh Convention Center is not available and expected expenditures are [REDACTED] prior to taxes and additional fees. This is a [REDACTED] bump from the last two conventions. Our next function is scheduled for September 24, 2016 at Saint Giles. Requesting removal of a trusted servant due to disruptive behavior. (see report). Questions were asked about the dates and options for the next convention and body was informed that no other weekends were available that month.

Old Business -

Concerns about the cost of the next convention. Convention Committee member informed body that they will be doing a “walk through” on September 12th at the Hilton and have to make a final decision by September 19, 2016 via contract. Body was informed that the contract or no deposits were made as of yet to the hotel. That she is also looking at other venues.

ASC body revisited last month’s request for removal of a member position. ASC Chair was open to members to voice about the incidents discussed in concerns and Convention Committee reports.

A member was voted by the ASC body to be removed from their position. Vote was 13 people for removal, 0 people against removal, and 4 abstained.

Intent: To begin a definitive way of incorporating CASC Policy into Subcommittee Policy.

Greetings Family,

First, I'm honored and so appreciative of your decision to allow me to serve as your Policy Chair for a 2nd Term. Thank you for your confidence in me.

As you know, I hadn't finished the Policy Manual the last time that we met because I did not have your permission to do so. But with the vote for the 2nd Term, I proceeded with updating of our POLICY Manual, finished it, and then immediately, requested that our ASC Secretary BLAST it to everybody on 8/13th. The POLICY MANUAL is now available on the CASC website. It includes all approved Motions up to and throughout July, 2016; therefore, I do not have any HARD COPY Motions for Policy inclusions. Effectively, now, any Motions voted on will be held, in hard copy, until the end of the quarter (October). I will update our Policy every 3-months.

Since we last met, I tried at least 3-times to reach Subcommittee Chair people, via phone and email. I emailed David (H&I), Curtis (Outreach), Lahoma (Activities), April (Convention) and Sara (PR) on 8/19th. In my email, I asked that they review the new Policy, especially, the recent changes, introduce the information to their respective Committees' during their business forums, then notify me if any changes were necessary via Motions that reflect their voting. In the same email, I advised them that all Policy on our website is now on a zip drive in my possession for any necessary changes. Although, I did hear from David (H&I) on the 19th, no conclusive changes have been made. He's to review their Minutes, then speak with his Committee for clarity, and let me know. April (Convention Chair) stated that she's working on the Convention Policy as there are numerous errors, repetitive lines and convoluted directions. Convention Policy may require an Adhoc Committee to correct and revise it b/c there may be years of voted-in business that did not get translated into their Policy.

(1) Last month, I asked this Body for guidance about what to do when there is no Subcommittee Policy contact? There is no clear Policy direction that mandates updating of Subcommittee Policy for consistency with CASC Policy. No discussion ensued. I recommend that the duty be delegated to the Subcommittee Alt Chair or the Chair. PLEASE DISCUSS... (If no Motion evolves from a GSR—Submit MOTION #1)

(2) I have each Subcommittee Policy on flash drive: downloaded from our website and converted into Word for the incorporation of changes...THE MASTER sets of POLICY. ASC Policy is current but theirs is not. I am concerned...Apparently, Subcommittees, like us, have difficulty keeping trusted servants in key positions; therefore, WE need a mechanism that can help them keep their Policy current. I'm uncomfortable with our Policy Manuals MASTER copies being "out there" with different/ever changing trusted servants or no one at all, who is committed to the project. I have learned thus far, that this one-duty has not been a priority among our Sub-committees; therefore, the Policies have suffered. Sub-committee foci have been on "getting the jobs done"! PLEASE...can we discuss this fact? I would appreciate sending this matter back to home groups for discussion as well, so that WE can brain storm. (MOTION #3)

(3) Last month, I mentioned to this Body the issue of the "RAFFLES" that we discussed at length 2-3-years ago: We decided NO, at that time, to no more than 2-Raffles per year (specifically for guidance with our Convention), however, nothing got put into Policy. With that said, I respectfully, ask that we re-visit this matter with the express purpose of including something into Policy for future reference and guidance. Please keep in mind, that home groups can choose to have raffles...I recommend that WE limit funding-raising via RAFFLES to twice a year. PLEASE DISCUSS. .MOTION #2

FINALLY, last month, this Body, ineffectively—in my opinion—attempted to assist the Convention Chairperson to address the disruptive behavior of one of its members. It has come to my attention that this same individual (that WE

allowed to stay) continues to be physically, threatening, aggressive, explosive and hostile. Their Treasurer resigned as a direct result and now the Chairperson intends to resign b/c of this person and other possible hostilities!

This individual demonstrated the exact same behavior in a public venue where this Area was conducting an activity. Admittedly, WE try to give our members the room to grow toward spirituality while serving in any capacity in NA, however, when a member, ANY MEMBER, presents themselves as a threat of harm to another, either via verbal or physical aggression, WE do NA a terrible disservice by not acting to preserve the integrity of NA as a whole. Not only does this sort of behavior impact another's willingness to serve, it creates fear in the newcomer; trusted servants become intimidated and will not fully, engage during business fearing the behavior will be directed at them; IT hampers the ability to conduct business, AND it sets a horrible precedence for other Addicts whose similar behavior require the same sort of tough love. WE do not tolerate or accept behavior that negatively colors NA: Remember Attraction rather than Promotion? NA is a safe platform to Recover. A RECOVERING Individual processes frustrations and anger—it is profound to witness! REMEMBER THE NEW COMER and what WE project to them and our community? WE DO NOT SANCTION AGGRESSIVE-BULLYING BEHAVIOR! I recommend that this individual be immediately expelled and banned from the Convention Committee.

September Convention Report

Hi Family,

Greetings from your 2017 Convention Committee Chair. Currently we are continuing the planning stage for our upcoming convention. Since we last met we have had two successful fundraisers. While both events were profitable, financially we are in need of continued support from the fellowship as a whole if we are to maintain the financial success experienced by the two previous conventions. Our financial needs have shifted as a result of the Raleigh Convention Center not being available for this convention year. As a result, we are having to explore alternative sites which will dramatically increase the cost of this year's convention. Previously (The past two years) we paid approximately \$5,000 for the convention, this year according to the proposals we have received we are looking at approximately \$ [REDACTED] Our next function is scheduled for September 24, 2016 @ Saint Giles, we ask that you announce this in your groups and come out as a home group and have your dinner served by your 2017 Convention Committee.

During last month's ASC I reported an incident had occurred during the last CACC meeting. As a result, a vote by the CACC Executive Committee to remove a committee member for disruptive behavior

was put on the floor and failed. According to CACC policy as the convention committee chairperson I am charged with bringing and allowing the ASC to make the final decision regardless of the outcome of the CACC decision. It was brought to my attention by an experienced members that I failed to provide information that was necessary for this body to make a clear and informed decision regarding that matter, for that I offer my apologies. Subsequently since we last met another incident involving similar behavior by the same committee member has occurred and again a vote regarding disruptive behavior was taken and failed. I must also add this incident involved me. As the chair of the CACC I again stand before you requesting that this body have the final say as outlined in the CACC policy regarding the behavior of this committee member (Page 5), Disruptive Behavior Section.

My decision to present the previous incident before this body was not of a personal nature but one that I view as part of my responsibilities to the ASC as the convention chair. As a trusted servant my intentions are to be transparent in the eyes of the fellowship and to not operate in a perceived fear or secrecy of the ASC. I honor my responsibilities as the point of accountability and if that means standing alone in the midst of adversity I will assume that posture but I will not be verbally

or physically intimidated but will serve in the atmosphere of love and mutual respect where each individual is allowed to express their viewpoint without fear of retaliation from others. Since our last ASC I have endured an attack on my character as a trusted servant where I was described as a failure as the chairperson of the convention committee in a text message by another committee member. Further this same member went on to describe my abilities as a trusted servant as ineffective and suggested I step down. I have served the CACC, the ASC and my home groups effectively and from a posture of love and mutual respect throughout my recovery and I know without any doubt that I have given my all for the love of recovery and the enhancement of our primary purpose.

I cannot and will not place myself in an atmosphere of service where the behavior that has been displayed is exhibited and simply passed off as, “let’s give her another chance” and I certainly will not be placed in the position where my spiritual wellbeing is chipped away by members who are unwilling or unable to work in an atmosphere of effective communication. As the convention chair I am responsible to the groups. I do not serve the CACC, I serve the groups who saw enough in me through my years of commitment, open-mindedness and honesty as a trusted servant whose leadership qualities are a true reflection of trusting the trusted servant. Trusted servants are not automatically

given their trust, that trust is earned by our dedication and responsibility to those we serve. I will not have my integrity tarnished or reduced by characters in a text or the disruptive behavior of any member. Effective NA leadership knows not only how to serve, but when it will serve best to step aside and allow others to take over. As a result I will be stepping down as your CACC Chair. I do not view the recent behavior and the subsequent inability of other committee members to place a measure of accountability as productive in the service area but view this as advantageous to the greater whole where the integrity of Narcotics Anonymous is sharply affected.
