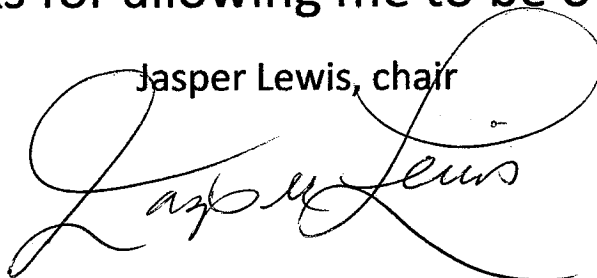
Chairperson report August 2, 2015

Question about direction to take with the Guidelines for Zonal Forum: to approve or not. Only 6 people took them back to groups What do you want us to do? Is this a move toward zonal representation? Per the RD/AD No, not in their opinion. Zone was not functioning before very well so new guidelines. Costal Carolina some feel zones are not doing anything. They are a waste of time and money... another layer of service. Florida wants support their motion for World board voting. Also support for a low cost book 1 to be printed by NAWS. Phil has a problem with using the words Zonal support as it will foster the Zone as another level of service. Note zones cannot make motions or vote on them.

Treasurer Report attached. O&F will be adopting a set of spending priorities due to the possibility of income being less than expenditures. (We will be in the red). Signatories on the checking account are a problem with the resignation of the facilitator and co-facilitator. We will need more people available to sign checks. A proposal will be presented in new business.

Questions voiced on cost of workshop for Zonal. CRCS will pay amount up front and will reimbursed by the other member Regions final cost to us approximately \$250.00.

Questions voiced on a rider for conventions with the insurance policy. Area will need to contact Dan. Addition information will be needed. Contact Dan for details. Minimum fee for a rider of \$200.00 May be able to submit request for multiple events for only one rider fee. No extra cost for the Zonal meeting here because we notified them about it.

Elections: Phil Elected/ Confirmed as Policy chair Unanimous No other nominations were made.

We need a Facilitator, Co-Facilitator and alt. Secretary. (Other positions were filled last year, term is for 2 years). Several people were suggested to fill these positions but all declined to be nominated.

New Business

7-1-15 Approved with 1 Assent with Reservation

Made by the Treasurer

Proposal: To include the Secretary and the Alternate Delegate to the list of signers on the checking account.

Intent: To assure continuity in service ie bill paying, deposits.

Explanation: policy p 45 states that The CRSC Regional checking account shall have at least 3 signatories of which 2 signatures shall be required on ant check. With the resignations of the Facilitator and Co-facilitator we had only the RD and the Treasurer left to sign check. This could result in delayed payment of our bills thence the proposal.

7-2-15 Approved with 1 Assent with Reservation

Proposal: To approve spending of up to \$400.00 for the Dec. CAR workshop sponsored by the SE forum.

Intent: To get the SE Zonal meeting space. CRSC will get 5/6 of the funding back from member regions.

Note Actual cost to rent the room is approximately \$1500 as stated in the original proposal. Since this amount was greater than \$1000.00 and would have to go back to the groups for approval, the amount was changed to \$400.00. The rest of the money needed is to be moved from the RD/AD budget for SE Zonal forum for 2015-2016. Check was written today.

Proposal Made By: Coastal Carolina Area

The Proposal Reads as Follows: That CBDM no longer be the process by which business at the CRSC is conducted. That we return to the traditional process of voting and decision making according to policy prior to the adoption/experiment of CBDM at the CRSC. In the case of lack or lapse of policy in the interim, the use of RRO as in the past.

The Policy Committee shall make the necessary changes to bring current policy back in line with the procedures used to conduct business prior to its implementation.

One year ago, this Area brought the concern of the use or lack thereof with CBDM in this Region. We explained that we were prepared to submit a proposal if it was not discussed and changes were not made, due to the lack of understanding, use and "translation" of CBDM. Discussion was had at the RSC meeting promising better implementation and actual use of one form or the other of voting, discussion and implementation of motions/proposals. We withheld this proposal contingent on improvement.

There has been no improvement. Confusion still reigns, the "dream" of CBDM is desired but the time it takes to actually implement is neither given, desired or participated in. Its use does not diminish the "politics" and manipulation and we feel actually increases it. The process does not translate well to the Area and Group level. (Most Areas are not using it to conduct business). Groups feel that CBDM leaves them out of the decision making process.

Overall, considering its original course of implementation and the results over the past 4 years-it is considered a failure in theory and use.

Intent: Follow a proven and understood method of conducting business. Improve communication and trust between Districts.

2-3-14 Revised Sent back to Area for a vote as is a policy change Policy recommendation was to add bullet 3 to this motion as it also is part of the motion

Proposal: To replace bullets 3 and 4 page 16:

* All persons nominated must be present at the election although the CRSC may, by consensus, allow the nomination of a person who is not in attendance.

Per Also question as to whether budgets should be voted as individuals or as a whole. Decision was made to vote on as a whole. Vote: 4 stand asides approved by simple majority. (Budgets are approved by a simple majority).

Concerns (All were voiced no paper forms available)

Concern from Twin City Over a Unity Day with PR. Money in budget to have learning days. Question as to whether there is a need to present a proposal for this. PR stated that Learning Days are in their work plan. Plans are to have joint learning days with H&I. Need support for events as not to squander resources.

Concern from Greater Charlotte Over amount in Insurance proposal: amount versus amount in report and the proposal for insurance. Insurance plan reviewed by Concern over the area being doubly insured with Regional and their own
