Minutes for the Capital Area Service Committee
April 2, 2017

Meeting called to order at 2:00 pm with the Serenity Prayer and reading of the N.A. Twelve Traditions and Twelve Concepts.

Roll Call

27 out of 51 Home Groups were represented. All 13 Officers and subcommittee chairpersons were present.

Approval of Minutes

Minutes were approved.

Concerns/Open Forum

Sebastian has paid off all debts to this area. (Amends statement made and a letter attached at his request).

- **Carolina Regional Report** -Alternate Regional Delegate Stephanie G.- Written Report.

9 areas are currently inactive, but are making donations. These areas are struggling to get members to serve as trusted servants. NAWs continues to forward requests to local ASC's and PR Subcommittees from facilities offering meeting space for NA meetings and requesting assistance with getting meetings started. During the January 2017 Regional Meeting, the NAWs spending was addressed and a request for a line items expenditure report of spending was submitted, which was not honored. Our Region is experiencing some controversy arising over individual groups "endorsing" conventions under the NA umbrella without accountability as these groups may not be acting accordingly to the 4th Traditions. These types of circumstances are happening in different areas, not just the "Serenity Fellowship Reunion". Let's keep this loving, not controversial. 1 of the areas (ECCNA) elected to spend the profit to jails and treatment facilities to support H&I with literature. An H&I Task Force and PR Task force were created for groups input. There is currently a motion in for funding the Mental Health Professionals Conference. You can visit SEZF.org-Zonal Website for information about all of the Regions.

Subcommittee, Officer and Ad-hoc reports (see attached)

Chairperson (Julius J) –Written report provided. It's been a good month. The Area Inventory is in motion. Elections are coming up, please put in resumes for the position of your interest.

Vice Chair (Richard B) –Written Report provided. I attended 8 of 10 home groups that have not attended ASC meetings in the last 6 months. 7 of 8 stated that they had only 4 or less homegroup members and many were newcomers and 4 of those groups stated that they will discuss during group conscience. There were concerns expressed by the groups including "the chair person would call on the same homegroups, too many personalities, disliking of the misappropriation of funds, and lack of change. A concern of H&I not utilizing/calling them was mentioned. We were the only 12 step meeting at an event in Wake Forest on March 10th.

Secretary (Candis D.) – Written report. In the month of March, written reports were provided as policy states. Thanks to those who provided written reports. I will be happy to guide the next person through the duties of this position for the upcoming election in June. There is no expense report this month.

RCM (Sheryl) -Verbal Report. The IRS is still investigating the Freedom Reunion and Serenity Fellowship Reunion. The people who held the convention will be held responsible, not the homegroup that "endorsed" nor NA at this time.

Alt. RCM (Gina)- No report.

Treasurer (Tim H.)– Written report. The revised February Statement is in the Treasurer’s report. It was discussed to ask the bank to change the closeout statement date due to not closing prior to the Area Meetings. As of March 8 2017, the starting account balance was: \$ [REDACTED] Deposits in March 2017 were \$ [REDACTED] from Homegroup Donations. There were \$ [REDACTED] in checks and deductions. The ending account balance as of April 2, 2016 was \$ [REDACTED]. Outstanding Check not cleared for \$ [REDACTED] (CASC Donation to Region). This leaves an available balance of \$ [REDACTED]. Policy Chair (Malinda J.)– Written report. I have re-inserted the Capital Area Financial Policy and emailed it to the webservant. H&I has started working on their policy and will not be going back into archives. I have nothing to report on PR policy updates. I met with members who showed interest in assisting with the Convention Committee Policy review on March 28, 2017. We started reviewing sections of the Convention Policy. Nothing will be changed until we bring this to the body for consideration.

Policy Alternate (Vacant).

PR (Craig R) – Written report. Presently our most urgent need is for a Vice Chair, Web servant and others to assist with the phonenumber and presentations. If anyone is interested or need more information, you can contact me at 919.618.7771. We really need all of our home groups (especially GSRs) engagement, direction and involvement in what we do to deliver effective services!! Come out to our subcommittee meeting every first Sunday at 12:30. Today we had 2 members attend for the first time and really appreciate them being present. PR Presentation was conducted in Wake Forest on March 11. We completed our monthly presentation at First Steps in Raleigh. We received 3 calls this month, primarily requests for information. We recently installed Googles Analytics code on the website to provide more accurate and descriptive information about visitors such as age, gender, location and search engines they used. For a two week period it showed 1,982 page views with the meeting schedule being the most popular page. The visitors represented over 25 states and 11 countries. We also installed a ‘Help Wanted’ page on the website that lists all the open service positions for the ASC and subcommittees. We are exploring future enhancements that might include a ‘Live Chat’ feature as well. The Facebook group is live. We encourage everyone to make announcements about it, particularly the name of the group so that people can find it. Also, encourage people to post announcements there. Please let us know if your meeting needs lists and we will get them to you. We have approved an updated version of our internal guidelines and a PR Orientation package. We plan on researching acquiring a new, easier to handle PR Display along with a projector and screen. These items are inexpensive and as property of our ASC, can be used by all the subcommittees and stored. Planning a poster drive possibly in May. Contacting Wake County Sheriff, Raleigh Police Department, Wake County Courts and Wake County School system for possible PR presentations

H&I Chair (David K.)– Written report. We have been offering H&I orientations at homegroups. For more information on the orientation, see Herb B or call at 919-327-7864. We discussed the H&I/PR/Outreach merge and the motion is postponed indefinitely. We had 5 cons and 1 pro. I may be absent in May and June and will coordinate with someone on the subcommittee to cover for me in the event that I cannot attend.

Outreach Chair (Curtis.) – Verbal Report provided regarding difficulty with completing tasks of heart and outlined due to being the only member of this subcommittee.

Activities Committee Chair (Lahoma.)–Written report. We are planning the next Capital Area Picnic to be in June of 2017. More information will be provided at a later date.

Convention Chair (Teddy K.) Written report provided. We need 14 more blocks to be filled for Friday and 24 more to be filled for Saturday night by May 15, 2017 until further notice. We have several events this month (see flyers in minutes, on the website, and on the FB page). We will have a Speaker Jam in Wilson, NC followed by a dance on May 20th, 2017. As of today, we owe the Hilton [REDACTED]. We will be making a payment of \$ [REDACTED] on April 3, 2017 to leave a balance of \$ [REDACTED] owed. CAROLINA REGIONAL REPORT (SEZF Meeting March 2017)

The Carolina Region continues to experience lots of growth. While nine areas are currently inactive, we continue to reach out and are working hard to discover solutions to the inactivity, and active areas are participating fully. NAWS continues to forward requests from churches and other facilities offering meeting space for NA meetings and requesting assistance in getting meetings started. We are forwarding those requests to local ASCs and PR Subcommittees.

Our January 2017 regional meeting in January 2017 addressed NAWS spending. After lengthy discussion, we moved to ask groups to allow our Region to audit NAWS spending for the 2014-16 cycle as outlined in the FIPT. That motion was withdrawn and replaced by a formal request by RCMs to the World Board to provide our region, as one of the beneficiaries of the Trust, with a line item expenditure report of spending for the cycle. The request was submitted, and the World Board's response was that they would not honor the request, stating they did not believe our region would benefit from any information a line item report may provide. We will consider exercising a review of the NAWS books at our next RSC, nominating a local forensic accountant to draw up parameters for such examination and represent the Carolina Region in the event we vote to examine the books and related potential travel to California.

Internally, our region is experiencing some controversy arising over individual groups "endorsing" or holding conventions under the "NA" umbrella without any accountability (especially financial) to a particular area or regional service body. While the autonomy of the groups discussed in Tradition 7 is acknowledged and respected, these committees may not be acting in accordance with Traditions that clearly direct such committees to be "directly responsible to those they serve". Our region encourages great freedom by groups in deciding how they carry the NA message, but many members are expressing concern that groups may be manipulating the Traditions in ways our processors never could have foreseen. We are happy to report that one of our Areas (ECCNA) elected to spend the profits from their recent convention to purchase 1,510 softcover Basic Texts for use in the prisons and jails they support.

Our Region elected a co-chair of the CRSC. We are also addressing the use of social media by our fellowship.

Finally, based on the resounding success of our region's public relations sub-committee participation in the Mental Health Professionals Conference in Charleston, SC last July, we voted to endorse participation in the Conference this coming July. However, since the amount requested is over \$[REDACTED] for literature and participation fees, the motion for funding was sent back to the areas for approval.

B: Too many personalities. One member even went as far as stating that their grandchildren did not behave that bad.

C: Did not like how the Misappropriation of funds was handled.
