April 8, 2018

Meeting was called to order by the Secretary (Janet W.) at 2:00 pm with the Serenity Prayer and reading of the NA Twelve Traditions and Twelve Concepts.

Roll Call

26 out of 54 Home Groups were represented & 9 Officers and subcommittee chairpersons were present.

Old Business

Motions and resumes from the March Area Meeting were addressed during this April meeting.

Motion I.

Made by Brian A. Our Common Welfare and seconded by Hiter, Our Primary Purpose

Motion, dated 2/18/2018, reads: For the 2017 – 2018 convention of the Capital Area to take this year as odd year and have convention in 2019.

Intent: So that the body have time to produce funds so that we don't go in the red.

Results: the motion was rendered obsolete due to previous motions that rendered this unnecessary.

Motion II:

Made by Trust the Process and seconded by Basic Text Group.

Motion, dated 3/4/2018, reads as follows: That the CASC Chairperson appoint an ad-hoc committee to reorganize and edit convention committee policies and procedures and that the ad-hoc committee provide monthly recommendations to the CASC and seek approval before any changes are made to the

said policy. The trusted servants who volunteered to participate on this ad-hoc committee include: Delphyne F., Terry S., Kelvin H., and John S.

Intent: To protect the integrity of Narcotics Anonymous its common welfare and better serve its primary purpose which is to carry the message to the addict who still suffers.

Results: The motion carried with 19 yes, 1 no, and 4 abstaining.

Motion III:

Motion made by Tuesday Night Live and seconded by Freedom thru Recovery.

The motion reads as follows: Change Policy, Section III, "description of subcommittees", general subcommittee guidelines to add a section on financial policy for all subcommittees. See attached.

To also be added to: Capital Area Treasurer Procedure Manual Section 4: Item 3.

Intent: To provide a method of enforcement and accountability to ensure all subcommittees comply with policy.

Motion IV:

The motion made by Trust the Process and seconded by Basic Text Group.

Motion dated 3/4/2018, see attachment for the complete reading.

Intent: To consolidate and enhance our service efforts and to be prudent with service related funds.

Results: Motion was tabled until the May meeting.

Motion V;

The motion was made by the Journey Continues and seconded by Trust the process.

The motion dated, 3/8/2018, reads as follows: GSRs will vote on a community day event on June 9, 2018 at the Convention Center and form an ad-hoc committee to decide the agenda which will hopefully include all subcommittees' participation. Sheryl is compiling a list of trusted servants who want to participate.

Intent: Promote unity in the Capital Area.

The motion carried: 13 yes, 3 no, and 10 abstaining.

Motion VI:

The motion was made by Trust the Process and seconded by Basic Text Group.

The motion dated 3/4/2018 reads as follows: That special elections will be held by the CASC in January of 2019 to elect new convention committees members (ALL) and that the new committee will resume its normal election process after the Convention in July or August of 2020.

Intent: To protect the integrity of Narcotics Anonymous, its common welfare, and better serve its primary purpose which is to carry the message to the addict who still suffers.

Results: The motion goes back to the home group for a vote.

Motion VII:

The motion was made by Trust the Process and seconded by Basic Text Group.

The motion dated 3/4/2018 reads as follows: That any money that remain after making reparation for cancelling this year's Convention be placed in an interest bearing checking account separate from CASC and remain in that status until January 2019. All current financial material be turned over to the CASC Treasurer for review and audit.

Intent: To protect the integrity of Narcotics Anonymous, its common welfare, and better serve its primary purpose which is to carry the message to the addict who still suffers.

Results: The motion goes back to the home group for a vote.

Motion I:

Some GSRs were concerned that the Executive Body made the decision to keep the Convention Center meeting space without having a GSR vote. It was explained to the GSRs that there was only one day left to hold the space or lose the \$650 deposit covering June 9, 2018. Two trusted servants of the area body

donated the additional \$100 needed with the understanding that if the GSRs did not want to move forward, then, they were willing to take the loss.

GSRs were concerned about the activities that would take place on the June 9, 2018. However, an ad-hoc committee had been established by the GSRs to determine the agenda.

Candice, the former treasurer of the Convention Committee reported that she has removed her name from the Convention Committee's signature card at the bank. She reported that she turned in \$443.78 to the CASC Treasurer.

General Subcommittee Guidelines

The following guidelines apply to all subcommittee chairpersons, and are in addition to the guidelines set forth by the subcommittees themselves.

1. Clean Time Requirement for Subcommittee Chairpersons

It is suggested that all chairpersons of ASC subcommittees have a minimum of 1 (one) year of continuous abstinence (or more if recommended by individual subcommittee guidelines) from all drugs.

2. Financial Policy for ALL Subcommittees

All subcommittees which handle money are required to provide a Treasurers/ financial report at each ASC meeting and sign a copy of the ASC's misappropriation of funds policy at the beginning of their term. In addition, all subcommittees which have a bank account are required to submit a copy of the bank statement or an account summary (online banking) for the month that is related to the report. Also, receipts are required for all monies paid out to stores, vendors or venues. **There are NO EXCEPTIONS. Failure to provide a FULL Treasurers report will result in the following:**

- a. ALL functions or fundraisers for that subcommittee will be immediately suspended until the FULL report, including bank statements is provided to the ASC. This applies even if it means loss of deposit/ monies for a venue that has been rented for a function, no exceptions. Any subcommittee that ignores this rule will be subject to rule b. below.
- b. If a full report is not provided within 2 weeks or if rule a. is ignored, the Chairperson and Treasurer of that subcommittee will be removed from office immediately. Additionally, they will be barred from ANY Area service positions for at least 1 year.
- c. In the event of removal, both the Chair and the Treasurer will be held personally liable for any money not accounted for or misappropriated.

3. Attendance Policy for Subcommittee Chairpersons

All subcommittee chairpersons are required to attend all ASC meetings. Failure to attend two consecutive meetings or a total of four meetings during a term of office is considered grounds for removal. Chairpersons who are going to be absent must notify the ASC Chairperson and submit normal written reports. The ASC may excuse an absence if it so desires
