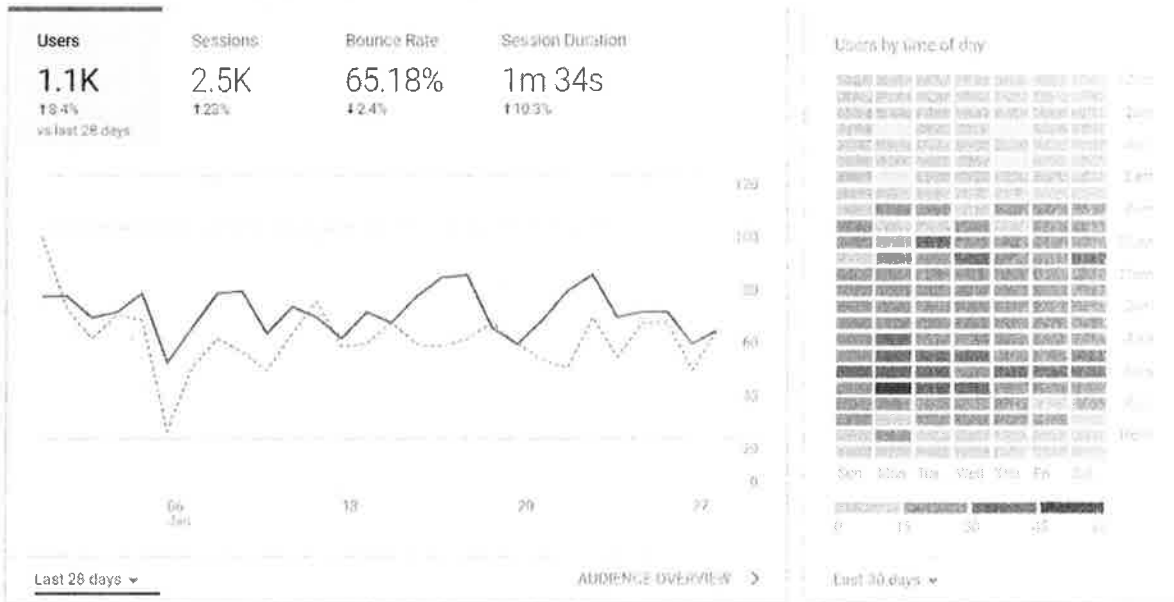

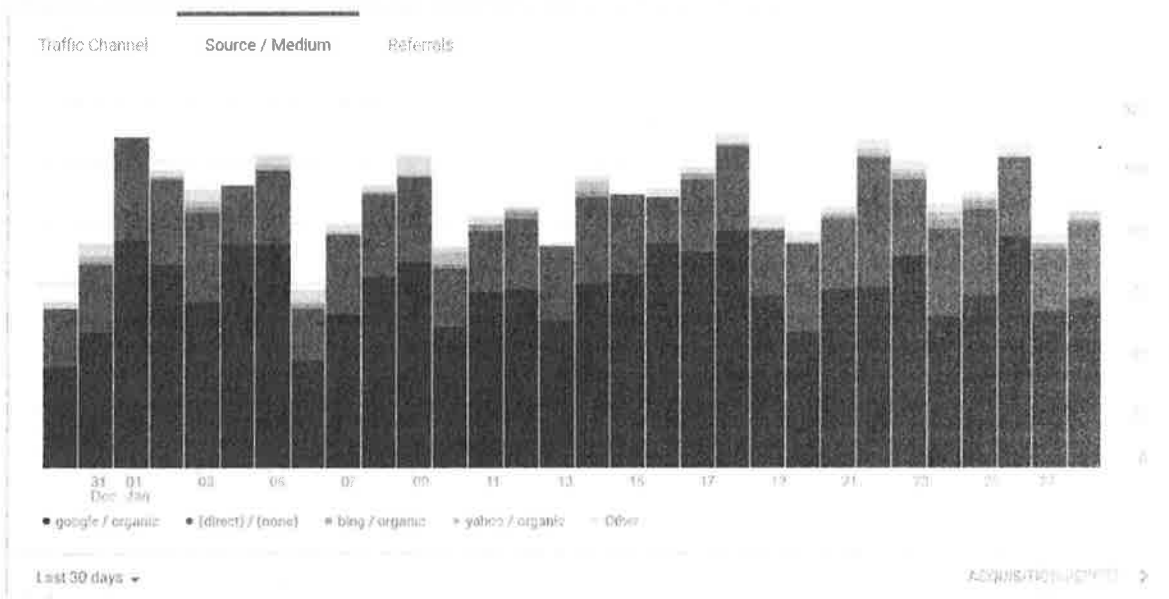

How do you acquire users?

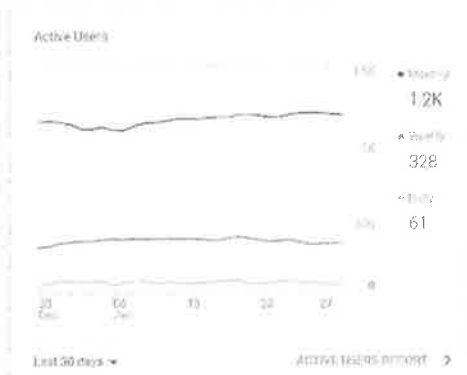

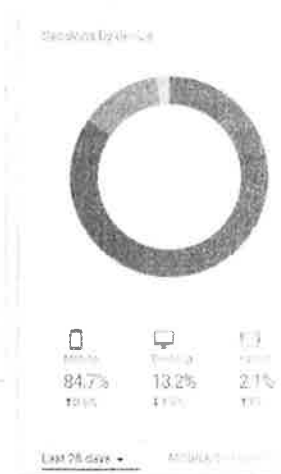

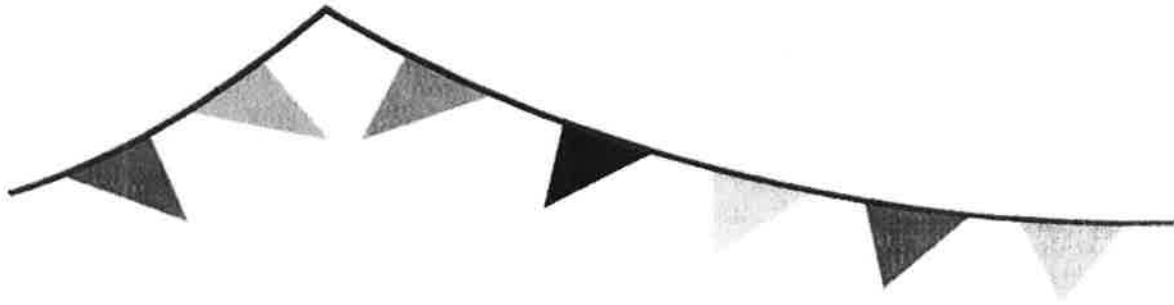
