

Stephanie T, Stephanie G, Elizabeth D and Ray L met as an Adhoc Committee via Zoom to discuss the pros and cons of possible changing Regions from the Capital Region to the North Carolina Region.

A little information of these two Regions are the Carolina Region is the largest Region in World consisting of North, South Carolina and a corner of Virginia. It has 23 Areas, 475 groups, and meets in Fort Mills, SC. The NC Region has 9 Areas, 130 groups and meets in Greensboro, NC.

We looked at the Pros for changing to the NC Region included –

It was smaller and more localized which would make it more fiscally responsible to attend their meetings because they meet closer to us. They are incorporated in North Carolina (in one state) which would help with conducting events and fundraising activities and be tax exempt. And in reading their policy, it is simple yet thorough and well done.

As we looked at the Cons we could not come up with any legitimate reasons not to change Regions.
