         This is included in the attached motion.
    - Proposal from Treasurer:
      - Out of the \$1449 donation from Convention, disperse the \$449 to Region/World at our normal split, then hold the \$1000 for things we do not know of yet (activities, supplies requested, etc. non-operating expenses)
      - Question: Don't we already have budgets for subcommittees?
        - o Response: Yes
        - Response: No money in that policy budgeted for phone lines, printing, etc.
      - Question: Does this functionally just raise the prudent reserve by \$1000?
      - Comment: Outside of the \$1800 prudent reserve, there's allocations for H&I, H&I learning day, outreach, policy (and I think one more)
        - No other areas
      - Comment: We already withheld money donating to Region and World for a significant amount of time during the pandemic when they needed it most. We should not do it again when our policy says we will donate.
      - Comment: Treasurer has not seen our prudent reserve go below approximately ~\$1200
      - Final Decision: Proposal withdrawn after significant discussion surrounding the purpose of a prudent reserve and policy
