“Workhorse” of the service structure—maybe that’s the best way to describe the area service committee. Most of the hands-on work of delivering NA services to the groups and the community occurs at the area level. Area service committees are ultimately responsible to the groups they serve. Narcotics Anonymous groups send group service representatives (GSRs) to serve on the area committee. While still maintaining final responsibility and authority for area services, they invest enough delegated authority in their GSRs—and through them, in the area committee—for the necessary work to get done. NA groups also send money to the area committee, money needed to coordinate panels, maintain phonelines, and conduct public information activities. Through their contributions of money and manpower, the groups exercise both their responsibility and their authority for NA services.

 - **Four new (or newly returning) GSRs:** New Beginnings, In From the Storm, Serenity in the Morning, and Never Alone Never Again
- **Concern:** An individual assaulted a homegroup member + makes female members at the meeting uncomfortable.
 - **Final Point:** This deserves more time than during this Area meeting, and will be discussed at the next town hall / round table (**on February 18th during the Unity Day event, 11a – 11p, at Greenwood Forest Baptist Church in Cary**)
 - Discussion Points:
 - Area needs to develop a culture of accountability (especially amongst men) that helps all members feel safe
 - Burden should not fall on individuals to solve.
 - It is the *group's* responsibility to keep members safe and maintain atmosphere of recovery
 - Town hall has been successful at providing a forum for addressing topics like this in our area.
 - Suggestions:
 - Individuals can make commitment to attend and provide support and safety.
 - Group autonomy allows homegroups to include language in their format affirming the commitment to safety of its attendees and members
 - **All members and groups should familiarize themselves with NA's stance and suggestions for dealing with disruptive and violent behavior** (Pamphlet found here: <https://na.org/?ID=servicemat-svc-pamphlets>)

- **Q&A on Servant Reports**

- RCM:
 - Conference Agenda Report (CAR) motions will likely require GSRs to coordinate with their own homegroup to determine how they would like to obtain a group conscience on CAR motions.
 - This likely entails meeting at a separate date and time than a regularly scheduled business meeting
 - RCM would like vote of confidence to propose that Ben C. from our area be the website coordinator for the NC Region.
 - **Decision: No opposition; RCM will propose Ben C. as website coordinator for NC Region**
 - **Spiritual Principle a Day (SPAD) website is now live;** (see RCM report for relevant region and SPAD links)
- Policy Subcommittee
 - Policy Subcommittee Chair will be meeting with 2022 Convention Subcommittee Policy Chair to review policy

- Comment: Important that people are getting involved in this subcommittee (and others) to have continuity of service experience and maintain current policy
- Convention Subcommittee
 - Will be providing a detailed report (27 pages) for last 16 months
 - Question: Do we have a current convention subcommittee? If not, who is being added to the bank account?
 - Significant discussion about existence of convention subcommittee following conclusion of 2022 convention
 - The 2022 Convention team is willing and able to continue to put on the one-day event in 2023 that the CASC voted on having.
 - Elections related to the 2024 Convention will happen in June 2023 alongside CASC elections.
 - Concern: The Area Chair and Area Treasurer should be added to the Convention bank account during the “gray area” of the subcommittee realigning with the convention timeline.
 - Justification: Responsibility and oversight of the Convention subcommittee funds should be at the Area level because per policy there just isn't a convention subcommittee.
 - Comment: These next 6 months might be a good time for those who are interested to participate in the Convention to get familiar with the roles before elections
 - Comment: Perhaps we just focus on where we go from here. Two main things to deal with now: Who puts on the one-day event in June, and who holds on to the money until June
 - Straw Poll: Who is on the checking account until June?
 - Only the Area Chair and Treasurer? 3 votes
 - The Area Chair and Treasurer and 2022 Convention Chair: 13 votes
 - **GSRs are good with moving forward with Area Chair, Area Treasurer, and 2022 Convention Subcommittee Chair on the account until June**
- Unity Day Ad Hoc Report Questions
 - \$100 going to rent, \$300 for the event itself (food, etc, no further details about budget)
 - Comment: Policy states activities subcommittee has \$200 in budget, so really the Unity Day Ad Hoc is only asking for \$200
 - Concern: Subcommittee and ad-hoc are not the same thing
 - Ad-hoc committee's assumption is that the funding is for the anniversary day specifically.
 - Ad-hoc committee will bring forth the proposal for funding in February
 - Concern: How long is the activities ad-hoc chair elected?
 - Response: Activities chair resigned. GSRs selected current unity day ad-hoc chair for 6 months. Can be renewed or not but hasn't been yet.
- **New Business**
 - Welcome new home groups joining Capital Area NA of NC (if any).
 - Last call for new motions, proposals, and service resumes.
 - Motion (attached): Donation for use of facility for CAR workshop
 - Principles Before Personalities seconds
 - 2 oppose, 0 abstain, 13 in favor
 - **Decision: Passes**
 - Motion: Monthly Area Clean Time Celebration + Potluck
 - Seconded
 - Would be new to our area. Time for everyone to eat and celebrate if they celebrated an anniversary in the last month. Only area expense is the rental expense, (no DJ, etc.)
 - Would like to include anniversaries including those less than a year (30 days, etc.)
 - It's not a meeting, it's a meal and celebration.
 - Oppose: 1, Abstain: 2, In favor: 11
 - **Decision: Passes**
 - Would very much like to change to begin in January; CASC Admin to investigate
