NA groups also send money to the area committee, money needed to coordinate panels, maintain phonelines, and conduct public information activities. Through their contributions of money and manpower, the groups exercise both their responsibility and their authority for NA services.*

  - Question: Is Chris willing to put this on?
    - Chris is, as well as the other people on the ad hoc committee
  - Suggestion: Convention committee puts on this event as they have been trained. Can we try to incorporate Convention committee to combine our limited resources?
    - Idea of an Activities task team to bring us together. Could bounce between events that we have (Convention, Unity day, speaker swap, monthly clean time celebration)
    - Just people willing to help out, with someone(s) leading individual projects.
    - Called "Fellowship Service Team" in a different service body


